



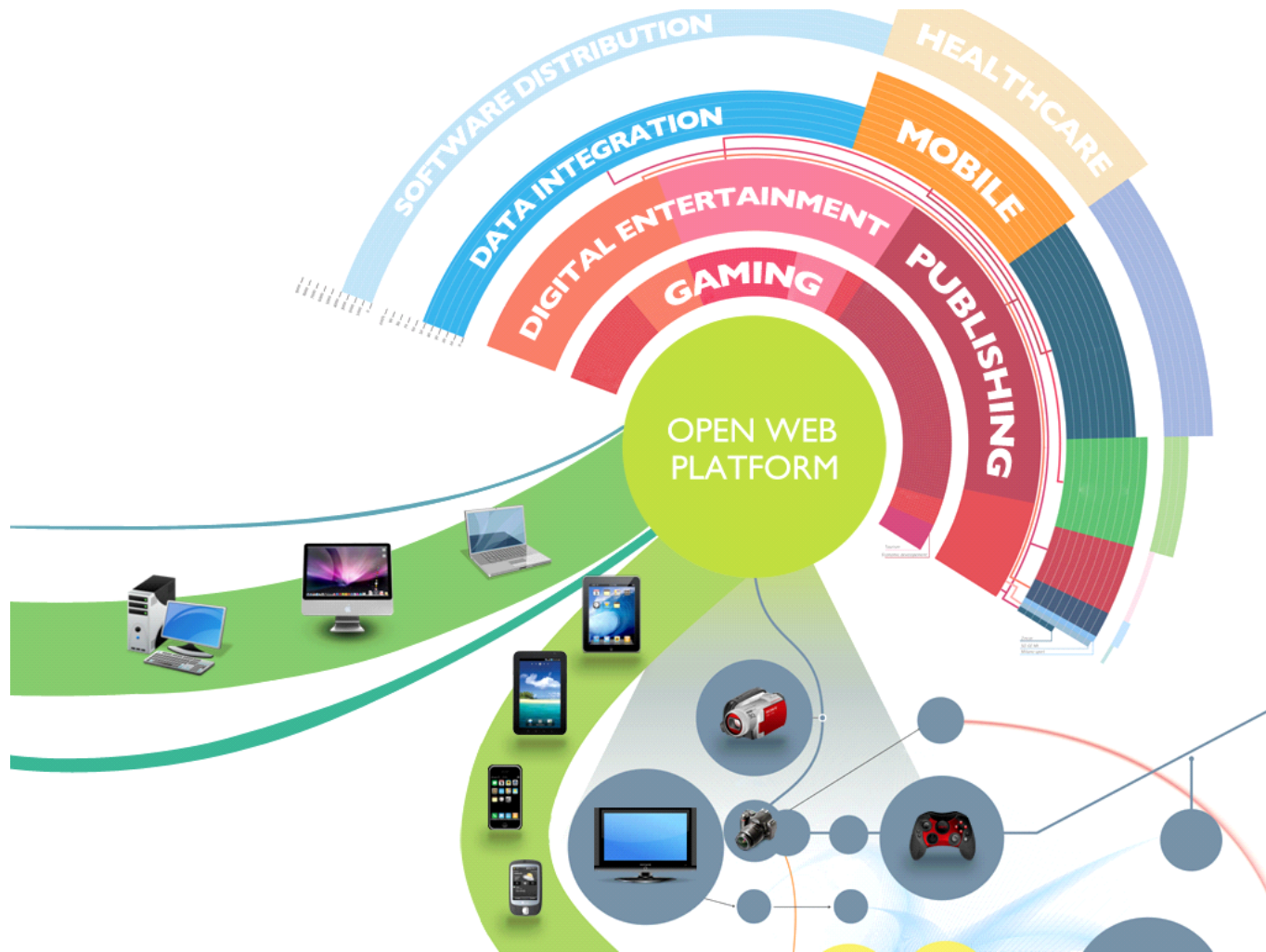

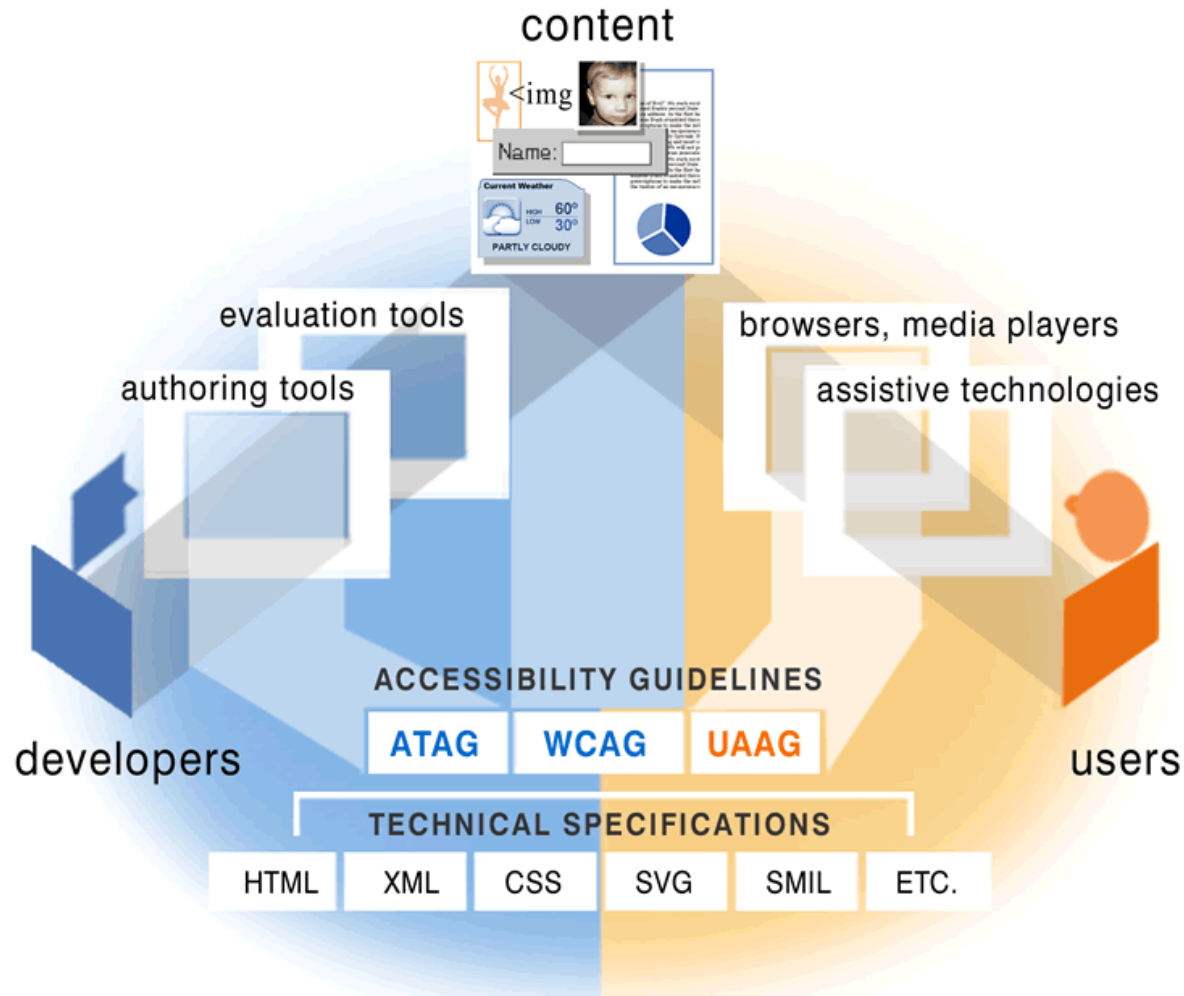

Internationally recognized accessibility standards:

- Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG)
 - Also available as ISO/IEC 40500
 - Referenced in Section 508 (US)
 - Included in EN 301 549 (Europe)
 - ...
- User Agent Accessibility Guidelines (UAAG)
- Authoring Tool Accessibility Guidelines (ATAG)

Increasing relevance for people with disabilities:

- Accessibility support in W3C technologies
- WCAG Mobile Accessibility Task Force
 - Mobile Accessibility Mapping
 - WCAG 2.0 Extensions
- User Agent Accessibility Guidelines (UAAG)
- Mobile Web Best Practices (MWBP)
