

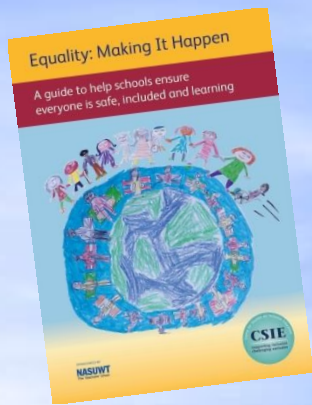

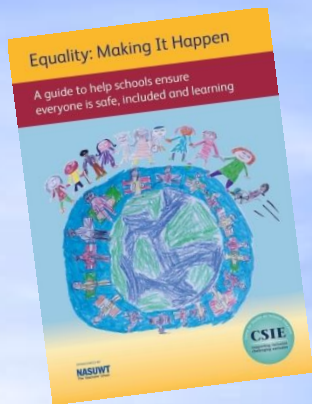

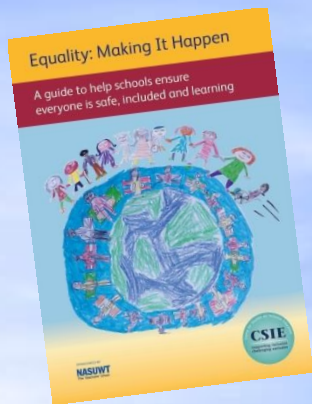

Introduction to the guide

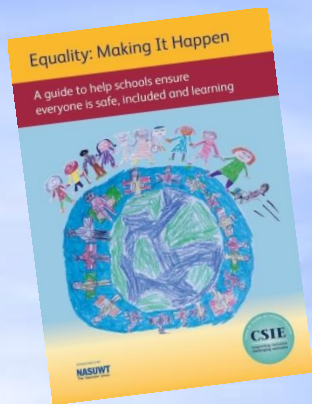
- succinct, user-friendly and “seductively practical”

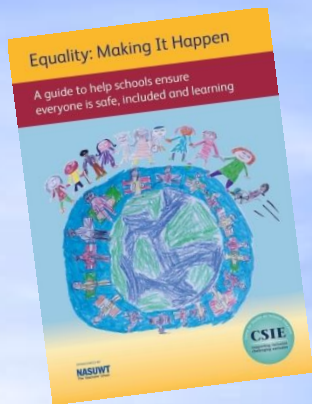

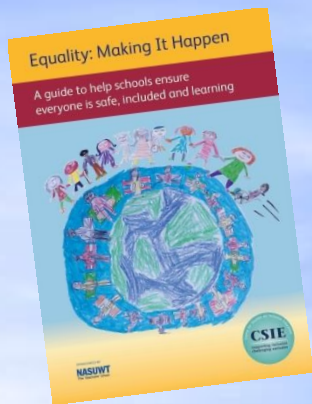


Equality: Making It Happen
